

## Entry and quarantine in the Azores

- Upon entry into the Azores, you must either be able to present a negative PCR test performed no more than 72 hours before boarding or antigen test performed no more than 48 hours before boarding, an immunity passport (if you have been infected with Covid-19 valid from the 11th day of issue and up to 180 days) or a valid EU Digital Covid certificate (vaccination 2nd and / or 3rd plug, both valid for 270 days).
- However, it is also possible to have a PCR test done on arrival and go into isolation in your holiday home until a negative result is found, usually 12-24 hours after the test. It is free to test on arrival.
- It is no longer necessary to fill out the online form.
- Travelers whose stay lasts longer than 7 days must be tested for covid-19 again on the 6th day after the date of the first test result. As a traveller, you are responsible for contacting the authorities to have your test performed. Additional information will be provided at the airport upon arrival.
- Also note that there is a requirement to show a negative covid-19 test when traveling between the islands.
