

### **Vaccinated travelers:**

Travelers who have been vaccinated with the 3rd vaccination (booster vaccine) are exempt from the requirement of quarantine and testing upon entry into Turkey.

Travelers who have received the second vaccination at least 14 days before entry into Turkey are exempt from the requirement of quarantine and test upon entry into Turkey. There is currently no information on the expiration of the 2nd vaccination.

Travelers who have received the 1st vaccination must present either a negative PCR test performed within 72 hours prior to entry into Turkey or a negative antigen test (rapid test) performed within 48 hours prior to entry into Turkey.

Travelers must use either the Danish/Swedish corona passport or the European corona passport (EU Digital Covid Certificate) as documentation for vaccination.

Turkey recognizes cross-vaccination if it is approved in Denmark/Sweden.

### **Previously infected:**

Travelers who have previously been infected are considered immune for 180 days after diagnosis. However, entry can only take place 28 days after a positive test.

Travelers must use either the Danish/Swedish corona passport or the European corona passport (EU Digital Covid Certificate) as documentation of immunity after previous infection.

Travelers who can document immunity after previous infection are exempt from quarantine requirements and tests upon entry into Turkey.

### **Neither vaccinated nor previously infected:**

Travelers who have not been vaccinated or previously infected must present either a negative PCR test performed within 72 hours

prior to entry into Turkey or a negative antigen test (rapid test) performed within 48 hours prior to entry into Turkey.

### **Rules for children**

Children under the age of 12 are exempt from the above rules.
